How is Pre-School different to Nursery?

- ❖ At Little Acorns we open 38 weeks a year offering 2 ½ or 4 or 5 ¾ hour sessions.
- In contrast Nurseries generally open all year round, Mon–Fri, offering care from 8am–6pm.
- Nurseries are particularly aimed at families where parents work full time and need longer hours of childcare than we offer.
- There are 2 Nurseries in Shaftesbury Flying Start and North Dorset Children's Centre.

The Nursery Grant

❖ All 3 and 4 olds are entitled to 15 hours of free nursery education for 38 weeks of the year or 30 hours if you are eligible. This can take place in nurseries, preschools or with childminders. The 15 hours can be used in one or more setting.

❖ The Pre-School was opened in Sept 2000 with the aim of meeting the needs of the local community, by providing an excellent quality of care and education for young children and their families.

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- The Pre-School is part of Father's House, Shaftesbury; which is a charity, and therefore non-profit making.

- ❖ Mon & Fri 10am 2pm. These sessions are only open to the children who will be starting School the following September. We call these our R4S (Ready 4 School) sessions.

- The Pre-School supports children's learning and development within the framework of the 'Early Years Foundation Stage' (EYFS).
